The abstract should start with a title and be structured as follows: introduction including objectives and theory, methods, results, and conclusion and discussion including recommendations for policy and/or practice. The maximum length of the abstract is **250 words**.

Abstract submission deadline: **Wednesday, 6 September 2017**

Candidates will be notified before: **Friday, 22 September 2017**
