The Generation Equality Forum is a global process initiated by UN Women to celebrate progress since the Beijing Conference on Women in 1995 and to keep gender equality and women's rights on the international political agenda. In the past year, six thematic multi-stakeholder action coalitions and a global compact were launched to develop priority actions and foster new commitments to further the Beijing agenda.

Together with representatives from the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs, this meeting will provide a space for civil society in the Netherlands to share reflections and discuss strategic opportunities for advocacy following the Generation Equality Forum in Paris (30 June - 2 July 2021).

Although the Generation Equality Forum's agenda is wider, this debriefing will primarily zoom into these four thematic areas:

- Youth participation (as cross-cutting theme)
- Women, peace and security (Compact)
- Bodily autonomy and sexual and reproductive health and rights (Action Coalition 3)
- Feminist movements and leadership (Action Coalition 6)
