Objectives

The morning programme consisting of two sessions:

Opposition to CSE:

Over the past few decades, while comprehensive sexuality education (CSE) has been increasingly taken up in national policies and implemented in schools, resistance to CSE has become vocal in several countries around the world. During the first session, facilitated by KIT Royal Tropical Institute, we will dive into the rationales driving opposition to CSE and discuss strategies on how to best respond and facilitate dialogue.

Assessing risks and increasing resilience in dealing with opposition:

In the second interactive session facilitated by Justice for Prosperity, we delve further into the arena of the opposition that you may encounter in your work. Different anti-rights actors use varying tools to further their agenda. JfP will guide you through their research into the actors and how they operate in different locations across the world. Combining key elements from five of JfP's dedicated awareness and risk pieces of training, we will also learn what it means to look through a security lens, to make us more resilient in dealing with opposition and hostile situations, and how to be prepared.

The afternoon programme consists of:

Introduction to Deep Democracy

Better Future will facilitate an introductory session on Deep Democracy, an inclusive dialogue method. The purpose of the session would be for you to experience and therefore learn to use some of the dialogue tools from the field of Deep Democracy. This would be especially valuable for SRHR professionals from the Netherlands as they work in the international field of SRHR and on quite sensitive issues where cultural norms/beliefs, human rights and laws and policies intertwine. We hope that by the end of the session you are able to grasp the basic steps of the dialogue to apply in your own work.
