# Contraceptives: what they are & who are using them

## Contraceptive



/Contraceptive/

noun

any of various devices or drugs intended to prevent pregnancy. Some also protect against sexually transmitted diseases and infections.

## Adolescents across Europe from 2014 to 2022<sup>1</sup>



70% used condoms or birthcontrol



61% of boys used a condom during last intercourse



57% of girls used a condom during last intercourse

## Sexually transmitted infections<sup>2</sup>

In 2022, STI cases **shot up** compared to the previous year, with gonorrhea rising by **48%**, syphilis by **34%**, and chlamydia by **16%**.

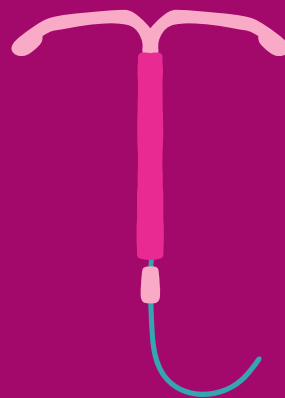


Protects against STD's & STI's, easy to use effectively



Does **not** protect against pregnancy

## IUD



99.2-99.9%

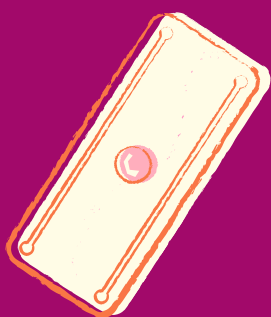


Protects against pregnancy, can last for 8 years, no maintenance



Does not protect against STD's & STI's, low accessibility, side effects

## Morning after pill



98-99%

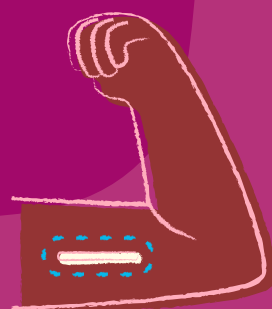


For emergencies, can be taken within 5 days after sex (but the sooner the better)



Does not protect against STD's & STI's, must be taken within 72 hours post sex

## The implant



99.9%



Protects against pregnancy, can last for 3 years, no maintenance



Does not protect against STDs & STIs, low accessibility, side effects

# Why contraceptives are HOT



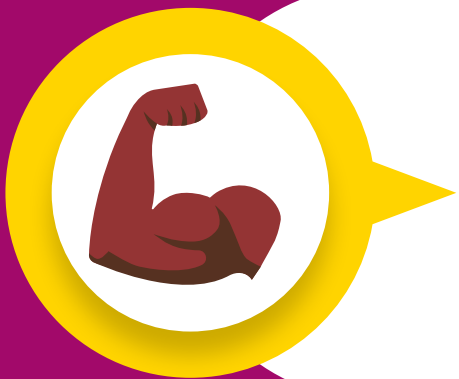
## By being safe, your sex is better

Sex can be way **more enjoyable** when you're not constantly worried about "what ifs." Knowing you're protected helps you **relax** and **enjoy** the moment more.



## Empowerment and Control

When you use birth control, you're in charge of your body and your choices. This **freedom** means you can focus on having fun without worrying too much about getting pregnant or catching something.



## Body Confidence and Security
